The Correlations between emotional intelligence with aggression behavior to deaf-mute adolescent, (Niken Widiastuti, M. Si, Psi and M. Nisfiannoor, M. Si, Psi); Psychology Study Programme, Undergraduate Programme, Tarumanagara University. (62 Pages, R1 - R4, A1 - A65).

The goal of this research is to search relation between emotional intelligence to aggression behavior on the deaf-mute adolescent. Emotional intelligence is ability or skill that has been individual to motivate the self, to perceive and understand feeling undergone both in itself and other individual. Aggression behavior is behavior emerged due to the excitement of anger is aiming to wound, either to disorder, damage and threaten other individual, both direct and indirect. Data taken of this research using questionnaire spread to 111 the deaf-mute adolescent in Extraordinary School B division in Jakarta. The *Spearman RHO Correlations* is used to analyze the data. The result of research shown that there is a negative and significant correlations between emotional intelligence with aggression behavior to deaf-mute adolescent $r_{xy} = -0,206$, p < 0,05.
