**The Correlation between Self-Disclosure and Marital Satisfaction in Young Adulthood Men; Miniwaty Halim, M.Psi & Yeni Anna Appulembang, M.A., S.Psi. Undergraduate Program in Psychology, Tarumanagara University, (i-xvii; 76 pages, R1-R5, Appdx 1-75)**

The aim of this study is to determine the correlation between self-disclosure and marital satisfaction in young adulthood men in Jabodetabek. This study involved 253 young adulthood men aged 21-40 years old that have been married for 1 until 5 years and have at least one child, by using purposive sampling technique. Based on hypothesis testing using Spearman Correlation, obtained that there is a correlation between self-disclosure and marital satisfaction in young adulthood men. The variable of self disclosure and marital satisfaction shows  $r = 0,815$  and  $p = 0,000$  ( $p < 0,01$ ). This results indicate that there is a positive and significant correlation between self-disclosure and marital satisfaction in young adulthood men. Subjects with a high level of self-disclosure will have a high level of marital satisfaction.
