The Relationship Between Mental Health and Achievement Motivation in Early Adolescence (Fidelis E. Waruwu, M. Sc., Istiani, S. Pd., M. Psi. T.); Psychology Study Program, Bachelor's Degree, Tarumanagara University, 48 pages, P1+P2.

Achievement motivation is one of the crucial element in the process of learning. Mental Health is a factor that can influence one's achievement motivation. The aim of this study is to determine the relationship between mental health and achievement motivation in early adolescence. Participants were 171 first year students of SLTPK IPEKA Tomang, sampled using the purposive sampling method. Measurements were taken using questionnaire based on Likert Scale. Data analyze was showing that significant 2 tailed score was $0,000 < 0,05$ and the correlation coefficient was 0,630. Result was concluding that there is a positive relationship between mental health and achievement motivation among the first year students of SLTPK IPEKA Tomang.
