Advocate profession also known as *Officium Nobile*, a noble profession, but today it's no longer known as a noble job. This profession more known as commercial profession which causes advocates has two sides of life, ideality and reality. As idealist, advocates have to raise justice without differ the client for their economy status, but in the other hand advocates need money for daily life. That issue not fulfilled when the client has economy problem, that's why both sides may cause intrapersonal conflict. The purpose of this research is to get full picture of intrapersonal conflict had by advocates and intrapersonal conflict resolution that they do. This research involved five subjects with age range 35 to 53 years old whom have work as an advocate for 5 to 10 years. Collecting data was done by interview method since March 2009 until late April 2009. The result of this research indicates that the subjects are having intrapersonal conflict when working as an advocate. The subjects also do the conflict resolution to overcome the intrapersonal conflict, especially in maintaining good relationship, determine the purpose, and finding alternatives.
