The purpose of this research is to know correlation between self-esteem and conformity with cheating behavior in early adolescence, with self-esteem as a moderator. Self-esteem in this research using theory from Christopher J. Rook and Karen Owens, meanwhile conformity is using theory from David G. Myers and Kevin Wren. Theory about cheating is taken from Anne Lathrop and Kathleen Foss. Research method that being used is quantitative descriptive correlation study. Data acquisition technique that being used by researcher is simple random sampling technique. The research result using Spearman correlation show  $r_s(417) = .161, p < .01$ . The conclusion of this research according to the result is self-esteem and conformity in early adolescence affecting cheating behavior in early adolescence.
