Description of self-concept on adolescent girls who have fathers with extra-marital affairs (Meiske Yunitree, M.Psi., & Dra Ninawati, M.M); Psychology Study Program. Bachelor Degree. Tarumanagara University. P1-90, P1-P3.

This research is aimed at finding the description of self-concept on adolescent girls who have fathers with extra-marital affairs. Self-concept is an individual self-evaluation. Extra-marital affair is an affair of a spouse with others outside the legal marital relations. Data collection was conducted by using in depth interview. Four (4) adolescent girls participated in this research. The result indicates that all participants tend to have negative self-concept related to their fathers' extra marital affairs. The negative self-concept influence negatively on their self-esteem. They feel ashamed on their fathers, and their self-trust tend to be low as well. They also tend to criticize themselves in a rather negative way. They tend to consider that father with extra marital affairs is a form of insufficiency in their personal development.
