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The purpose of this research is to increase the attention on children who have Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD) through the application of positive reinforcement in play activities. Collecting data on ADHD is obtained through the screening process, such as observations of the child, interview with the parents and teachers, as well as IQ tests done on children. The number of subjects used in this study as many as two people, which consists of two boys who were collected through purposive sampling technique. Results obtained by application of positive reinforcement as much as nine sessions with a duration of 30 minutes each session and be given four times a week effective to increase attention to children (middle childhood) who have Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD).
