physical, personal, and fun. Theraplay use to develop a healthy interaction

between parents and child also enhance attachment, confidence, and trust in

healthy relationship. Theraplay is activity between 30 – 45 minutes. This method

is an interactive game with parents so a healthy relationship can be develop

between mother and child. Result showed that theraplay is effective to increase

attachment between mother and child with early age who has become the victim

of divorce.
