The Influence of Extrovert and Introvert Personality Type Toward Anxiety of not Having Mate In Female Young Adulthood (Sandy Kartasasmita, M. Psi. & M. Nisfiannoor, M.Si., Psi.); Study Program Bachelor Degree in Psychology, Tarumanagara University, 70 pages, R1-R4.

Anxiety of not having mate happened because of many pressure from surrounding environment in female young adulthood. Anxiety also influenced by personality.
