## ABSTRACT

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Connection between *self efficacy* and the athletics achievement of mentally retarded athlete (Dr. Monty P. Satiadarma, MS/AT, MCP/MFCC); Study Program of Psychology. Program Sarjana Strata Satu, Tarumanagara University.

The Purpose of this research is to find the relationship between self efficacy and achievement on Special Olympic athletes (mental retarded). Self Efficacy is a person's evaluation on his or her capacity to accomplish a task. Achievement is the score to evaluate a person's capacity to have a certain ability. The Special Olympic athletes consider that the function of achievement is for the self and family pride. This quantitative correlational non-experiment research uses questionnaire on 26 participants. The statistical analysis uses Spearmen rho correlation. Results indicate that r(26)=0.042,  $\rho$ =0,840>0,01, thus there is no correlation between self efficacy and achievement on Special Olympic athletes.
