Research is conducted to know the description of emotional jealousy in lesbian couples who are in a romantic relationship with fellow lesbian. Emotion felt by jealous lesbian couples are emotionally jealous that is not much different from emotion felt by the heterosexual in general, only the differences in behaviour that is very possessive indicated by the lesbian. The incidence of emotional jealousy can be caused by several factors, among others: like the third person in a relationship that sometimes cause a feeling less confidence in the pair.
