the trash picker's children who is adolescent at Jakarta in reaching their goals.

Amount of subjects is three with several criteria, which is late adolescent (17 until 21

years old), live in excrete area in Jakarta, have minimal rate 70 in their raport, and

their parental get income just from trash picker. They are living in poverty condition

and insecurity by criminal offence. They have high self-efficacy to persistence for

doing anything efforts in reaching their goals, such as learning at school, working,

and reading a book. They also have positive moods so that can handling their
