Differences of Body Image Satisfaction Level between Extrovert and Introvert Personality in Late Adolescence Female; (Denrich Suryadi, M.Psi; Mardiana, Psi.); Psychology Study Program, Undergraduate Level Program Tarumanagara University, (83 pages; P1-P4, L1-L51).

Physical changes in adolescence can influence body image satisfaction level. Body image can be defined as individual's subjective experience evaluation of physical appearance; such as height, weight, and other part of body. The aim of this research is to find out differences of body image satisfaction level in late adolescence female, between adolescents whom have extrovert and introvert personality. Sample of this research is adolescent girls (age 17 to 21) in Jakarta. The instrument in this research is questionnaires, which are given to 223 subjects. The data are analyzed by independent sample t test method. In this research, showed that there are differences of body image satisfaction level in late adolescence female, between adolescents whom have extrovert and introvert personality, exclude illness orientation. Late adolescents female whom have extrovert personality have higher body image satisfaction level than late adolescents female whom have introvert personality.
