The impact of neglectful parenting style on middle childhood children whose come from families of fisherman. (Debora Basaria, M.Si. Psi.). Undergraduate Program in Psychology, Tarumanagara University. (80 pages, R1-R3, Appdx 1-9).

Neglectful parenting style are the attitude of parents who have low control in their family, not involve in the decision of their children life, has no response or expecatitons, and have no emotional attachment with their children. Fisherman are the jobs where individuals work at sea to catch fish or others form the body of water. This research measure impact of neglectful parenting style using in-depth interview that included three subjects as a method of data analyzing. The subjects in this research are middle childhood children who have been treated with neglectful parenting style. This research start from 11 September 2010 through 14 September 2011. Based on interviews within the subjects having the results that the physical impact, cognitive impact, psychological impact, and behavior impact are experienced by fishermen children whose been treated with neglectful parenting child. Physical impact are seen by lower attention of health and hygiene, cognitive impact are seen from the low educational achievement and delay of cognitive development, psychological impact are seen from loneliness and failure in emerging relationship, and behavior effect can be seen from the attitude of the children.
