The correlation between self esteem and need for affiliation of the student (late adolescent) in organization. (M. Nisfiannoor, M. Si., Psi. & Sesilia Monika, M. Psi.). Bachelor degree in psychology, Tarumanagara University (65 pages, P1-P4, L1-L50).

Students in their college life not only study in class, but some of them involved in student organization for their relationship. Someone need to make relationship is called need for affiliation. Moreover, one of the factors which influenced someone need to make relationship with others is self esteem in themselves. Self esteem is someone judgment toward themselves. The judgment based on appearance, performance, or someone talent. Subject in this research consist of 161 student which study at X University with age 18 – 21 years old. The method used in this research is quantitative non-experiment, using Pearson's correlation test. The result is $r = -0.377$ and $p = 0.000$. Based on the result of this research, there is a significant negative correlation between self esteem and need for affiliation. Therefore, someone with high self esteem might be not able to interlace relationship with others.
