

## ABSTRACT

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***Trust and the Marital Happiness from the Commuter Marriage Couple.*** (Naomi Soetikno, M.Pd, Psi). Bachelor Degree of Psychology.Tarumanagara University, Jakarta.(79 pages, P1-P4, L1-L34).

This study is purposed to figure out the correlation of trust and happiness of marriage life for the couple who live in commuter marriage. The research method that is used is quantitative method with non-experimental study. The data sampling is taken by spreading the questionnaires about both of the variables. The research subject for this study is man and woman in the young adults phase, in the age range from 20 to 40 years old for some 200 people. The subjects have been married and live separately with their partner outside the city. The timeline of the study is started from July 2013 to September 2013. The result of this study that use the correlation test with Spearman Correlation shows that trust variable has significant relation with the happiness or happiness of marriage, with the  $r$  score = 0,243 and  $p$  score = 0,001 < 0,05, so,  $H_0$  is rejected, and  $H_1$  is accepted. It means there is positive and significant relation. From the correlation test with Spearman Correlation, it is obtained that in trust variable there is only dependability dimension that does not have relation with happiness variable. While the result of correlation tests from happiness variable, it is only sex dimension that does not have relation with trust variable.
