Rejection from workmates because of being coming out is an unpleasant thing for

gays, especially when doing their work. The research is aimed to know the

depiction of resilience of gays who already be coming out in their workplace.

Besides, it is also to know the reasons of gays to be coming out in the workplace

and its risks. Resilience is an ability of human to face, conquer and be tough of

the misfortune they get (Grotberg, 1999). Gays who already be coming out and
