The problem of juvenile delinquency is the main problem faced by most of society,

such as criminal acts, fight, free sex, drug abuse, and murder. Murder is a juvenile

form of aggressiveness can be seen from the aim, norm, and form (Berkowitz, 1995).

Things can affect the aggressiveness is surrounding environment, such as elements

of family, peers, school, and neighborhood known as elements in microsystem

(Bronfenbrenner, 1975). The aim of this research is to know the effect of the

elements in microsystem of aggression in adolescent murderer, as well as to see the

most element in microsystem affect aggression. The method of this research is a

mixed method, involved 15 quantitative subjects and followed by three subjects

interview. The results of this research by quantitative method showed no difference

between effect of the elements in microsystem of aggression in adolescent

murderer, but qualitative data found elements in microsystem influence on the

aggression in adolescent murderer of three subjects.
