In early adulthood, women began entering the workforce without leaving domestic role as a woman, it will affect the role of the run work and married. Marital satisfaction is general appraisal toward marital condition that had been around and subjective. Aspects of marital satisfaction is communication, leisure activity, religious orientation, conflict resolution, financial management, sexual orientation, family and friends, children and parenting, personality issues, and equalitarian role.
