The role of cultural values and parenting styles toward the intention to determine majors in university; Naomi Soetikno, M.Pd, Psi. Undergraduate Program in Psychology, University Tarumanagara, (i-xv; 88 pages, P1-P3, Appdx L1-L100)

The aim of this research is first, to find out the role of cultural values toward the intention to determine majors in university. Second, parenting style toward the intention to determine majors in university. The subject of this research consisted of 400 high school students at private and public high schools in Jabodetabek. The results showed that there was influence of cultural values, the dimensions of power distance to determine majors in university with score t = t = 2,125 and sig (p) = 0,034 < 0,05. And there was influence of the father's authoritarian parenting style toward the intention to determine majors in university, with score F = 4,097 and sig (p) = 0,044 < 0,05, and also the mother authoritative parenting style that was have influence, with score F = 4,691 dan sig (p) = 0,031.
