Marriage satisfaction is a result of subjective evaluation towards marriage quality

in general within some periods which changeable along the time passes by and

affected by individual experiences as well (Bahr, Chappell, and Leigh, in

Lailatushifah, 2003). Dwidjosumarto (in Somantri, 2006) stated that someone who

cannot hear or lack of hearing is a hearing-impairment. The aim of this research is

to get a picture of marriage satisfaction of a young adulthood man who got married

to a hearing-impairment woman. There were three subjects between 29-35 years

old and live in Jakarta for this research. This research used a qualitative descriptive

method combined with interview and observation for its data compiling. The result

shows that although not every component of marriage satisfaction is fulfilled on

those three subjects, but in generally they are satisfied with their marriage. The

condition of subject's wife also not causing any conflict in their marriage life.
