Persecution is a crime that is unlawful and involves legal subjects. Molesters could have been done by teenagers, such as existing data shows that youth as perpetrators of abuse has increased every year. Action adolescent maltreatment is associated with emotional intelligence possessed by teenagers. This study aims to look at the picture of emotional intelligence which is owned teenagers and provide a deeper understanding of intelligence emoional. This study was conducted on 114 adolescents who were in prisons Jakarta and Bangka, with characteristics of subjects aged 11-20 years and youth as perpetrators of abuse. This study uses non-experimental quantitative methods with descriptive design. The results of the data analysis of the five dimensions of emotional intelligence that there is *self-awareness*, *managing emotions*, *motivating one-self*, *empathy skills*, and *handling relationships*, show that adolescents as an abuser has a value of self-awareness that is likely to be smaller than the other dimensions. However, from the overall results show that adolescents have high emotional intelligence.
