

ABSTRACT

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**Correlation Between Religious Commitment dan Meaning in Life in Late Adolescent;
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Religion has long been known as the central source of meaning in life, providing the individual core beliefs, expectations, and objectives. The objective of this research is to identify the correlation between religious commitment and meaning in life using quantitative non-experimental design with correlation technique in late adolescent. Convenience sampling used as a sampling technique (N=389). Religious commitment which is defined as the degree to which a person adheres to his or her religious values, beliefs, and practices and uses them in daily living, meanwhile meaning in life defined as human beings have a strong desire to understand themselves and the world around them, understanding of the meaning, significance, and purpose of their lives. According to Spearman correlation, there is positive and significant correlation. This is shown from $r_s = 0,402$ dan $p = 0.00$. The result based on data analysis when subject have high score in religious commitment then meaning in life score is high. Otherwise, when subject have low score in religious commitment then meaning in life score is low. Additional testing can be done from the other viewpoint like effect to see if religious commitment affects meaning in life.
