

ABSTRACT

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The role of personality type (*Big Five Personality*) against dimension self disclosure of social media users. (Erik Wijaya, M. Si). Subject of Bachelor Degree in Psychology, University of Tarumanagara (i-ix;60 page,P1-P4; L1-L56).

The objective of this research is to investigate the role of personality type (*Big Five Personality*) against dimension self disclosure. Type of personality is an important thing in human's life, because it is related to a person's behavior personality is a 'picture' of how someone acts toward the surrounding environments, which can be seen from the habits of thinking, attitude, and readability, also the unique view of his/ her life to have the constancy. The research is conducted on 296 late-adolescence at 'X' university with the sampling characteristic ages of 18 to 21 years old. The research is using non-experimental quantitative method which called Quasi-Experimentation. The analysis result is using linear regression test to the role of personality type against self disclosure shown the score $r^2 = 0.233$, $F = 17.656$ and $p = 0.000 < 0.05$, type of *openness personality* $t = 0.053$, $p = .958 < 0.05$, type of *conscientiousness personality* $t = -4.439$, $p = 0.000 < 0.05$, type of *extraversion personality* $t = 6.764$, $p = 0.000 < 0.05$, type of *agreeableness personality* $t = 3.229$, $p = 0.001 < 0.05$, and type of *neuroticism personality* $t = 4.175$, $p = 0.000 < 0.05$, thus there occurred the significant role between type of personality (*conscientiousness, extraversion, neuroticism*) against self disclosure.
