The Correlation between Big Five Personality with Self Adjustment in Student Nomads; Sandy Kartasasmita M. Psi.; Undergraduate Program in Psychology, Tarumanagara

The aim of this research is to know the correlation between big five personality with self

adjustment in student nomads. This study involved 67 student nomads universities in Jakarta

using accidental sampling and snowball sampling. This study is using correlational design of

quantitative method and analyzing with Spearman correlation. The results are openness to

experience r (67) = 0.185 and p = 0.133, conscientiousness r (67) = 0.420 and p = 0.000,

extraversion r (67) = 0.423 and p = 0.000, agreeableness r (67) = 0.538 and p = 0.000, and

neuroticism r (67) = -0.288 and p = 0.018. The result indicates that there are significant positive

correlation between conscientiousness, extraversion, and agreeableness with self adjustment.

Openness to experience showed a positive correlation but not significant with self adjustment.

Whereas neuroticism showed a significant negative correlation with self adjustment.
