ABSTRACT

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Relationship of Academic Anxiety with Academic Integrity towards Students who will face a Computer Based National Exam; Monika, M.Psi and Erik Wijaya, M.Si; Undergraduate Program in Psychology, Tarumanagara University, (i-xi; 60 pages; P1-P6; L1-L21)

Academic integrity is defined as a student's honest and responsible behaviour in regards to all kinds of academic propositions. Academic integrity is influenced by aspects such as institutional and demeanour. One of the demeanour aspects that influence the academic integrity is the academic anxiety. This research aims to discover the relationship between academic anxiety and academic integrity for students who are going to undertake the computer-based national examination (also known as *Ujian Nasional Berbasis Komputer (UNBK)* in Bahasa Indonesia). This research applies a quantitative method by distributing questionnaires to 12th year students in Jakarta Barat area. The evaluation instrument used for the purpose of this research is an analysis instrument of academic anxiety and an analysis instrument of *The International Center for Academic Integrity*. The results of this research show that there are negative and significant relationship (r = .477, p = .000 < .05) between academic integrity with academic integrity.
