

ABSTRACT

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Subjective Well-Being on Emerging Adulthood with Physical Disability Due to a Traffic Accident; Meiske Yunitree Suparman, M. Psi., Psi.; Undergraduate Program in Psychology, Universitas Tarumanagara, (ix; 106 Pages; P1-P5.; L1-L18)

On average, the victims of traffic accidents are people between 15-22 years old. Traffic accident causes people experience disability such as physical disability. People with physical disabilities has several difficulties such as finding a job, that cause people feel insecure and ashamed because of her/his physical condition and start to withdraw themselves from the society. This condition affects the subjective well-being of people with physical disability. Subjective well-being has 3 components: (a) life satisfaction; (b) positive affect; and (c) negative affect. The purpose of this research is to describe the subjective well-being on emerging adulthood with physical disability due to a traffic accident. This study used 3 subjects (1 male and 2 female) with a range of age between 18 to 25 years old who had a traffic accident at the range of its age. This study used qualitative methods with in-depth interview technique. The result of this study showed that each of the subject has good quality of subjective well-being.
