**Relationship Between Self-efficacy and Career Maturity in Vocational Students;

Career maturity is achieved through individual behavior and ability in accomplishing tasks on career development. Attitudes and abilities of an individual will be influenced by their point of view in the results that have been achieved called self-efficacy. the purpose of this study was to determine the relationship between self-efficacy and the career maturity of a vocational high school students. The participants in this study were 345 students in vocational high school. On this study the sampling technique used is convenience sampling. Data was collected by using a self-efficacy questionnaire and career maturity questionnaire. Data analysis using Pearson correlation techniques through SPSS 21.0 for Windows. Correlation test results show that self-efficacy has a significant positive relationship with career maturity which results in a value of $r = 0.273$ with $p = 0.000 < 0.05$.
