

ANALISIS PENGARUH CURRENT RATIO, EARNING PER SHARE, PRICE
EARNING RATIO, RETURN ON EQUITY, DAN DEBT TO EQUITY RATIO
TERHADAP HARGA SAHAM PERUSAHAAN NON KEUANGAN YANG
TERDAFTAR DI BURSA EFEK INDONESIA PERIODE 2011-2015

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The purpose of this research is to analyze the influence of financial performance to the stock price of non-financial companies which are listed in the Indonesia Stock Exchange. The indicators used in this research are Current Ratio, Earning Per Share, Price Earning Ratio, Return on Equity, and Debt to Equity Ratio. The timeframe observed in this research is between 2011 to 2015.

This research uses secondary data which were collected from www.idx.co.id. The data consist of financial statements from various industries other than financial industry and have been audited on 31 December. This research takes 137 samples of non-financial companies. These companies were selected based on specific criteria which were developed by using purposive sampling method. This research uses data panel with a multiple linear regression analysis and processed with Eviews9 application.

This research argues that based on t test, Earning Per Share and Price Earning Ratio have significant effect on stock price of non-financial company. However, Current Ratio, Return On Equity, and Debt to Equity Ratio have no significant effect on stock price. The F test shows that Current Ratio, Earning Per Share, Price Earning Ratio, Return On Equity, and Debt to Equity Ratio jointly influence the stock price
