However, there are some input from the review as follow:

 Please use the Indonesia Law Review (ILREV) writing guidelines for formatting, including margins, indentation, footnotes, and bibliography.
 Overall, the substance is quite adequate. However, the review regarding theoretical studies on the form of efforts to conserve marine fisheries resources in the ASEAN countries' Exclusive Economic Zones (EEZs) from a legal perspective, including the novelty of models that need to be offered, is not sharply discussed. The author only focuses on descriptive explanations. It would be advisable to elaborate on how the conservation efforts discussed by researchers relate to the assurance of fishery resource sustainability, whether this has been achieved or not in terms of existing policies and the models to be proposed by the author. This is important considering the increasingly complex issues in the maritime fisheries sector. The emergence of problems in the fishing area carried out by foreign fishing vessels in the territorial waters of Indonesia and the Indonesian Exclusive Economic Zone poses potential losses for Indonesian fishing vessels.

The analysis has been performed adequately. There is a need for further refinement in the analysis section. In this regard, the author needs to elaborate in more detail on the existing conditions regarding the governance of fishery resources in the EEZs concerning the problems and solutions to achieve the sustainability of these fishery resources, especially from the author's perspective in legal studies. Thus, it should not merely contain manuscripts that are only reviews or summaries.

In general, the substance of the manuscript has discussed adequately the connection between the conditions and potentials of fishery resources in the EEZs concerning the problems and solutions to achieve the sustainability of fishery resources in the EEZs. Some suggestions to strengthen the analysis in the substance of your journal are as follows: it could be supplemented with a brief discussion on the conservation of fishery resources at sea through a regulatory model regarding sustainable fishing, marine spatial planning through fisheries management areas such as in Indonesia, Integrated Coastal Zone Management, as well as policies using blue economy and blue justice approaches. Regarding the regulatory model for fisheries management areas or sustainable fishing, it is also necessary to develop a fisheries management area plan by classifying these areas based on the differences in fishing zones for the needs of industrial and small-scale fishermen. Based on Article 1 paragraph (1) of Government Regulation of the Republic of Indonesia Number 11 of 2023, Sustainable Fishing is defined as "controlled and proportional fishing, conducted in the regulated fishing zones, based on fishing quotas in order to maintain the sustainability of fishery resources and their environment as well as to distribute the national economic growth evenly".

Additionally, it could also elaborate on the efforts of governments in ASEAN countries, including Indonesia, to enhance integrated surveillance systems in these areas by developing more efficient strategies, including technology-based approaches (e.g., through the utilization of vessel monitoring systems). All forms of policies in each ASEAN country developed through the Blue Economy and Blue Justice approaches stem from the understanding that environmental sustainability is a crucial aspect of global economic development and welfare, while also preserving fishery resources in Indonesia. Such discussions can strengthen the urgency or significance of raising the topic of this research.






