**Religiosity and development stage of conventional morality in last adolescent of Buddhist. Study in adolescent at Buddhist monastery in Bogor. (Dra. Fransisca Iriani, M. Si., & Meiske Y. Suparman, psi.). Bachelor degree in Psychology, Tarumanagara University (80 pages, R1-R4).**

Religiosity is a major factor in human moral development. Religiosity is intensity level of people religion in comprehend and practicing their beliefs. Morality is a system of value that has teached human being about the way to do their life with goodness. Morality becomes very important to be practiced in Buddhist life. This research tries to describe the correlation between religiosity and development stage of conventional morality in last adolescent of Buddhist who has stayed in Bogor. Sample of this research consist of 130 adolescent in Bogor, who has characteristics such as age between 17-21 years old and Buddhist. This research used a quantitative method. Based on data analitycs of Spearman correlation's test found that  $r(130) = .555$  and  $p = .000$ . The research concluded that there is a tight relationship and significant between religiosity and development stages of conventional morality.
