Fanaticism and Trait-Personality for Predictors Aggressive Behavior among Supporter of Soccer (Study X soccer's club Supporter in Jakarta); Bonar Hutapea, M.Si. Undergraduate Program in Psychology, Tarumanagara University. (i-xii; 61 pages, appdx 1-48).

Competitions such as football fanatics always brings the audience to support their club for any reason in situations where the conditions, rules and norms may be easily violated that leads to aggressive behavior. This study examined whether the relationship fanaticism and personality impact on aggressive behavior as a predictor of the psychological concept. This research method is accidental sampling technique to members of the official supporter's club football in Jakarta. There are three questionnaires consisted of Buss-Perry aggression questionnaire, Big five inventory, and scale fanaticism. This study shown there is no significant relationship between fanaticism and personality attributes to aggressive behavior. There are several reasons why it is not proven that fanaticism is not a negative phenomenon and there is no direct connection from the angle between the theory and the statistical properties of personality and aggressive behavior.
