Although the leadership of Gajah Mada has been known, described and studied

in many ways but none of his leadership styles been studied psychometrically.

This study aims at developing Gajah Mada leadership style based on asthabrata

dimensions: (a) angkasa; (b) rembulan; (c) air; (d) samudra; e) bumi; (f) angin; (g)

api; and (h) matahari. The Gajah Mada Leadership Scale (GMLS) was developed

by considering content validity, face validity and criterion validity as well as

internal consistency and test and retest reliability. GMLS used the pictures of

former Republic of Indonesia presidents as stimulus in order to measure the

psychometric of the asthabrata dimensions studied. This study involved 135

middle adult between 40 until 65 years old respondents from Tangerang and

Jakarta and resulted in valid and reliable 55 items measuring GMLS.
