non-probability sampling technique. The results of the data analysis in this study

are that the form of un-involved parenting style and authoritarian parenting style

have a tendency to do sexual behaviors that tend to extremes stage, whereas

parenting tend to form sexual behavior tends to be low is the form of authoritative

parenting style and permissive parenting style. From the results of the

crosstabulation between parent's parenting style and sexual behavior, the form

of un-involved parenting style has a high percentage of each of the stages of

sexual behavior, such as touching, kissing, petting, and intercourse.

Authoritative parenting style has a low percentage of each of the stage sexual

behaviour, such as touching, kissing and petting.
