ABSTRACT

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Development of New Norm of Needs Instrument of Edwards Personal Preference Schedule (EPPS) (Studies in Adolescence Participants at Jakarta); Putu Tommy Y. S. Suyasa, M.Si., Psi. & Denrich Suryadi, M.Psi. Undergraduate Program in Psychology, Tarumanagara University, (i-x, 56pages, P-1 – P-5, L-1 – L-16)

The aim of this research is to develop new norms of EPPS based on last 3 years adolescence participant data, because there's a misapplication norm in age group is not appropriate. The process of reaching these goal is done with 3 steps, they are: with get the description of mean score from last 3 years participant data, and then it will compare with mean score of EPPS norm at 1975. Last, the new norm of EPPS will be developed. The sampling process in this research is use incidental sampling. The result of this research shows that from the last 3 years participant data, the needs who have a higher mean score is *Achievement*, *Affiliation*, *Intraception*, *Abasement*, *Nurturance*, *Change*, *Endurance*, *Exhibition*, and *Dominance*. The *Needs* who have a average mean score is *Succorance*. While the *needs* who have a lower mean score is *Deference*, *Order*, *Autonomy*, *Heterosexuality*, and *Aggression*. The comparison result between 1975's mean score of EPPS with last 3 year mean score of participant data shows a significantly differentiation at the whole kind of needs. From this result, researcher will create and offer the new EPPS norm based on last 3 years adolescence participant data who have a formal study.
