The analysis interview results concluded, there are presences of anxiety that parents, friends or partner knowing the commercial sexual activities. Also feeling of moral guilt and anxiety of sexually transmitted diseases. They do Problem Focused Coping (PFC) in the form of direct action, seeking assistance, information seeking and Emotional Focused Coping (EFC) in the form of avoidance, denial, positive reappraisal.
